**Terms and Conditions:**

- Applicant must fulfill the minimum requirement to join the BDIX and thereby submit proper documents.
- All administrative contacts to be proceed with SDNF.
- SDNF will be responsible for entire administrative and technical management of BDIX. Policy decisions will be done by SDNF Executive Committee. However a technical team comprising of members from the representatives of connected ISPs and SDNF may oversee the maintenance.
- BDIX shall support the IX end equipment and server support at the IX end.
- Participant ISPs cannot share their IX connectivity to other ISPs, who are not the member of BDIX. BDIX updates route information for members of BDIX only.
- A membership fee per month per ISP prevails till any further update.
- The linking ISP must have one unused Ethernet/Fast Ethernet port in their router.
- If the member is connected through DSL to the BDIX, it is ISP's own responsibility to maintain the link to the IX-end router.
- If the member is connected through own radio devices, both end equipment should be provided by the ISP, and operation of the radio link must be maintained by the particular ISP, without interfering the connected radio devices of the IX.
- Any ISP who would like to be disconnected from the IX can do that with a seven day's written notice.
- A member not paying membership fee consequently for 3 (three) months will be disconnected without any prior notice.
- These terms and conditions may change as per the need of the IX community, and approval of the SDNF Executive Committee.
